Have you ever been called to fulfill a difficult task?

2 years after Abinadi originally preached to Noah's people, he returned in disguise to tell them that they would suffer because they did not repent

1- Abinadi calls Noah & priests to repentance

Mosiah 12:1-8	Abinadi returned to tell Noah's people what?	They would suffer, bondage, driven & slain, famine, pestilence, destroyed
Mosiah 12:13-15	How did the people respond? Why?	Having fun as perceived by the world
Mosiah 12:20-21	What did the priests ask Abinadi?	They tried to 'cross' him, with questions about scriptures
Mosiah 12:25-27	Why didn't they understand this passage?	They failed to 'apply their hearts' to scripture study
Mosiah 12:28-37	What did Abinadi reveal about priests?	Teach LofM? Why not keep LofM? (brings salvation? Yes! Then teach it)
Mosiah 13:1-9	Why was Abinadi able to deliver his message?	Power of God intervened and priests did not dare touch him
Mosiah 13:11	Why did Abinadi read the 10 Commandments?....	Commandments not written in their hearts
Mosiah 13:28-31	What was the purpose of the law of Moses?.....

Are there things we can learn from Isaiah today?

Mosiah 15:9	How did savior satisfy the demands of justice?	Broke bands of death / took our sins upon himself
Mosiah 15:10-14	Who becomes heirs of kingdom of God?	Those who hearken unto words
Mosiah 15:11-25	This is the answer to the priests question.....	Mosiah 12:21
Mosiah 15:21-25	Who participates in first resurrection?	Believers, died in ignorance, little children
Mosiah 16:13-15	Abinadi counseled priests to do what?	Repent, teach it is shadow of things to come (faith)
