SUPPLEMENT #3 Elder Boyd K. Packer

"There are three parts to the plan. You are in the second or the middle part, the one in which you will be tested by temptation, by trials, perhaps by tragedy. ...

"Remember this! The line 'And they all lived happily ever after' is never written into the second act [of a play]. That line belongs in the *third* act, when the mysteries are solved and everything is put right. ... "Until you have a broad perspective of the eternal nature of [the plan], you won't make much sense out of the inequities in life. Some are born with so little and others with so much. Some are born in poverty, with handicaps, with pain, with suffering. Some experience premature death, even innocent children. There are the brutal, unforgiving forces of nature and the brutality of man to man. We have seen a lot of that recently.
